

Disposal of Church Property

When an item owned by the church is no longer in use, boards or committees may present a list of the items, their current value, and a suggested method of disposal to the Board of Trustees. The following options for disposal are in the preferred order:

- Repurposed within the church
- Given to another church in the denomination
- Sold to another church in the denomination
- Given to a Christian non-profit organization
- Sold to a Christian non-profit organization
- Sold to an individual in the church (e.g. silent auction, rummage sale)
- Set out in church building to be given away
- Sold to the general public
- Scrapped for cash
- Recycled
- Thrown away

The Board of Trustees shall publish a list of the unused items in the *Forward Look* and in the church building prior to the final decision.

The Board of Trustees will make the final decision on the current value and method of disposal of the unused property. They will then notify the committee initiating the request and the Official Board of the decision. The committee will be responsible for the disposal.
